INTRO: This is a hunting tournament being hosted for the first time in Nebraska. The tournament consists of up to 50 two- person teams that hunt for 1 day and must kill legal species bag limits according to Nebraska law. The event is timed, and teams are awarded points for filling bag limits, weapon selection for the species, and for the hours remaining after all bag limits have been legally taken and checked in.

CURRENT RULES, March 1, 2010

1. Teams are made up of only two hunters.
2. All registration paperwork must be completed prior to the event.
3. Legal hunting licenses and stamps for species being hunted must be validated before competing in the Challenge.
4. Two forms of valid identification must be validated with Challenge Staff.
5. Public hunting areas within the Halsey National Forest boundaries are the only location for participants to take species during the tournament. This tournament excludes the use of any CSA (Controlled Shooting Areas), private and leased ground.
6. All tournament fees must be paid in full prior to the Competition. Returned checks will be charged a \$35 fee.
7. Entries will be taken on a first come, first served basis. No places will be held without a deposit. Tournament is limited to 50 teams.
8. Nebraska Xtreme Outdoorsman Challenge reserves the right to refuse service to anyone, for any reason.
9. All team members will hunt all animals without the assistance of any other person or forfeit their entry in the challenge.
11. Each member must follow all State Wildlife rules and regulations for legally shooting all animal species acquired. Violations of any Game Regulations will be reported and violators will be prosecuted with the encouragement and support of the Nebraska Xtreme Outdoorsman Challenge, its management and its field observers.
12. The species to choose from are: Deer (muzzle loader or archery), turkey, bag limit of ducks or geese, bag limit of pheasants, quail, or grouse/prairie chicken for each team. * See "Points System" for specific scoring guidelines*
13. All teams will have a forest map assigned to them with designated check-in points. Your time and bag limits will be recorded by the staff and presented to the Challenge Management for official recording. Check-in staff is a neutral part of the competition and must be present when recording bag limits required by the Challenge.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS OR THE STATE WILDLIFE HUNTING REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
